Fr. Joseph Kuhlman, Parochial Vicar of Cathedral Parish, will be leading a Marian Consecration Preparation and Prayer Meeting on 5 consecutive Saturdays and on Friday of the 6th week, having our first meeting on Saturday April 7th and our last pre-consecration meeting on Friday May 11th at the Bosco House. Each of the 6 meetings has two options for the time of day. You can choose either one to attend: the morning and evening sessions will be the same. The times are 9:00-10:30 am and 7:00-8:30 pm. (The meeting during our 6th week is on Friday, because the priestly ordination Mass for our Diocese is on Saturday May 12th - please pray for our transitional Deacons John Sollee and Martin Ibeh who are to be ordained priests!)

If you have already made your Marian Consecration (we did this as a parish a year ago for the 100th Anniversary of Fatima), you are encouraged to renew your consecration with us! Going through the 33 days of preparation again will be a blessing to you, and Our Lady will bring new things to light each time you repeat this preparation!

The 33 days of preparation begin on April 10th for the May 13th Consecration. But, you can choose to make this consecration at other times also. The schedule of other dates for consecration are listed in the book.

We will join together on Sunday, May 13, 2018, at St. Benedict the Moor at 3:00pm for Holy Mass. We will pray the Morning Glory Consecration Prayer together at the Mass. Please mark your calendars now!
